Early marriages that occur are one of them caused by peers, peers greatly affect the sadness of early marriage, which in adolescents often tell how they are dating like having premarital sex, so that other peers listen and become curious and there is a sense of wanting to try it. there is no distance between the opposite sex, they are free to want to do anything and are free to want to hang out with anyone, today's teenagers have followed western styles, such as dressing immodestly, going out at night with the opposite sex freely, and freely engaged in married sex without any fear of health and future career, Karen was suggested was just a moment's pleasure.

INTRODUCTION

Marriage is an inner bond between a man and a woman as husband and wife with the aim of forming a happy and eternal family / household based on One God (Marriage Law No. 1 of 1974). In Law no. 1 of 1974, article 7 paragraph (1) states that marriage is only permitted if a man is 19 years old and a woman is 16 years old, the proposed amendments to Article 7 of 1974 paragraph (1) can and be done if the marriage is male and female. Minimum age 19 years, article 6 paragraph (2) to marry each prospective bride who has not reached the age of 21, must obtain permission from both parents.

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In the past 30 years, child marriage worldwide has decreased from 33% in 1985 to 26% in 2010. More than 700 million women currently living were married before reaching the age of 18, and one-third or around 250 million children married before the age of 15. It is estimated that 142 million girls (or 14.2 million per year) will marry before the age of 18 from

2011 to 2020. Child marriage is most commonly practiced in South Asia and Sub-Saharan Africa. India, which has a prevalence of child marriage of 58%, or more than one third of the number of child marriages worldwide. Of the 10 countries with the highest prevalence of child marriage, 6 of them are in Africa, including Nigeria, which has the highest prevalence, namely 77%.

The Central Statistics Agency and UNICEF noted that child marriage occurs in almost all regions of Indonesia. The highest average prevalence of child marriage (women 20-24 years who were married before the age of 18 years) in 2008-2012 was West Sulawesi (37.0), Central Kalimantan (36.3), Central Sulawesi (34.9), Papua (33.6), while Bengkulu Province occupies the 19th position out of 33 provinces in Indonesia. The number of adolescents who were married in 2012 was 7,424 women, while the prevalence of early marriage was 10.2.

Bengkulu Province Seluma District consists of 14 districts, one of which is the Ilir Talo sub-district. In Ilir Talo sub-district, which consists of 15 villages, there is still a high number of early marriages and a significant increase from 2013-2016, namely from 654 married couples, there were 218 (33.3%) incidents of early marriage with 16-19 years of age and 2017 out of 139 married couples, there were 50 (43.3%) incidence of early marriage with the age of 16-19 years.

The still high rate of early marriage, of course there are many problems faced by women who carry out these marriages, which have a very detrimental impact on women, both physically, psychologically, economically, autonomously and in education. In this regard, researchers are interested in doing research. The general objective of this research was to explore Peer Pengaru with the Incidence of Early Marriage due to promiscuity (Case Study) in the DistrictIlir Talo, Seluma Regency in 2020

METHODS RESEARCH METHOD

This research is a survey research with a qualitative approach to phenomenological studies, used to study in depth cases of early marriage in Ilir Talo District, Seluma Regency, including the causes of early marriage. The research subjects of all women who performed early marriages in Ilir Talo district in 2017 were 17 people. The object of research is the cause of early marriage among women in Ilir Talo District 202. The qualitative data uses observation, in-depth interviews, and documentation studies. This data analysis technique is the process of identifying categories to take conclusions based on information obtained

through observation guidelines, interview guidelines, and documentation studies. Data analysis in this study used content analysis.

From the 17 cases of underage marriages above, it can be seen that the factors in the occurrence of marriage are caused by various kinds of problems, one of which is the influence of peers and promiscuity.

Friends of the same age

Early marriages that occur are one of the big influences influenced by their peers because at this time teenagers already understand about premarital sex. If a person has had premarital sex, he will share his experience with his close friends. Based on the story from his friend, there was a sense of curiosity about having premarital sex with his girlfriend, so that the information spreads with other friends, where they can freely engage in premarital sex without their parents' knowledge, this curiosity does not only happen to sex. premarital, but that curiosity also arose when he saw his friend getting married. based on this curiosity someone will do the same thing, namely getting married at an early age. In this case, the role of parents is very important in supervising their children so that their children do not have promiscuity, which is when promiscuity has occurred, pregnancy outside of marriage can occur. This research is in line with research conducted by Eka Khaparistia, showing that the factors that influence early marriage are economic factors, peers, the desire of informants, family, and pregnancy outside of marriage

CONCLUSION

The occurrence of early marriages in Ilir Talo sub-district, Seluma district still needs to be considered. Menenga Atas schools, which previously were only conducted once a year, must now be added in order to create quality youth

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
